

Francis Barber Pupil Referral Unit

We would like to invite you to attend a Community Engagement Event to review revised plans for the proposed redevelopment of Francis Barber Pupil Referral Unit [PRU]. This public event will take place at Francis Barber PRU on Friday 9th February, between 5pm and 7pm, and is your chance to find out more information regarding the School's redevelopment plans before revised planning information is submitted to the London Borough of Wandsworth.

The project is part of the Department for Education (DfE) *School Rebuilding Programme*, in which Francis Barber PRU has been identified as one of the top priority schools across England in need of modernisation.

Plans have been developed in close collaboration with the school addressing specific educational needs. There will be no increase in pupil/staff numbers.

The proposals include:

- Replacement of existing buildings with a new purpose built 2-storey admin block and 3-storey teaching block [a set back is provided to the top floor facing Dewey St]
- Refurbishment of existing sports hall
- Purpose-built assembly hall
- Purpose-built external multi use games area (MUGA)
- Enhanced soft landscaping and biodiversity
- Secure bike parking facilities, no vehicle parking
- Net Zero Carbon in operation
